As a child he was very smart and was very quick at arithmetic and music. He learned the lyre and had a wonderful singing voice





Leonardo da Vinci is regarded as one of the greatest artists in history. Leonardo excelled in many areas including drawing, painting, and sculpture.

Two of his most famous paintings, and perhaps two of the most famous in the world, include the Mona Lisa and The Last Supper.


Many of his drawings were on the subject of anatomy. He studied the human body

His father (1719-1787) was from Augsburg and he was a composer. Mazart at the age of 5 had already composed small songs which he played to his father who was recording them. 
She was awarded the title of "Queen of Crime" which made her one of the most influential writers in the world.





Einstein's intellectual achievements and originality. have made the world "Finstein" synonymous with genious.


