She is best known for the 66 detective novels and 14 short story collections she wrote under her own name, most of which revolve around the investigations of such characters as Hercule Poirot, Jane Marple, Harley Quin/Mr Satterthwaite, and Tommy Tuppence Beresford.

William Shakespeare was baptised on 26 April 1564 and died on 23 April 1616. He was an English poet, playwright and actor and he is considered to be the national poet of England. MOZART

He was born in Salzburg on 27th January 1756 and died at the age of 35 in Vienna on 5 December 1791. He is one of the most important composers of classical music. He was the son of Leopold Mozart and Anna-Maria Pexle. The only of his siblings who survived was his eldest sister Anna-Maria. She was musician too. His father (1719-1787) was from Augsburg and he was a composer. Mozart at the age of 5 had already composed small songs which he played to his father who was recording them. The skills of young Mozart were unique. He could play the piano and the violin. In October 1769 Mozart moved to Italy with his father and became the headmaster of the orchestra. Few years later they returned back to Salzburg. From March 1781 Mozart was in Vienna. Mozart began composing and about half of his works were written in the 10 years of his stay in Vienna. At the last three years of his life Mozart (1789-1791) was artistically and financially successful. He was a patient from the summer of 1791 but in December his illness became more serious. Mozart had 2 kids, Karl and Wolfgang.

She was born on September 15 1890 and she died on January 12 1976, at the age of 86. She was an English crime novelist, short story writer, and a playwright.

She wrote 80 detective novels like: "The adventures of Hercules Poiaro", "Four weddings or Funerals", "Murder on the Orient Express" and "The Pact of Roger Akrount." She also did some movies like: "In the mirror I saw the murderer."

She was awarded the title of "Queen of Crime" which made her one of the most influential writers in the world.

Ludwig van Beethoven



Ludwig Van Beethoven was born on December 17th 1770, at Bonn. At an early age he took an interest in music and his father taught him day and night, on returning to the house from music practice or the tavern. Without a doubt, the child was gifted.

On March 26th 1778, he gave his first public performance at Cologne. His father announced that he was 6 years old, but he was 7½. So, for the rest of his life he thought that he was a year younger.

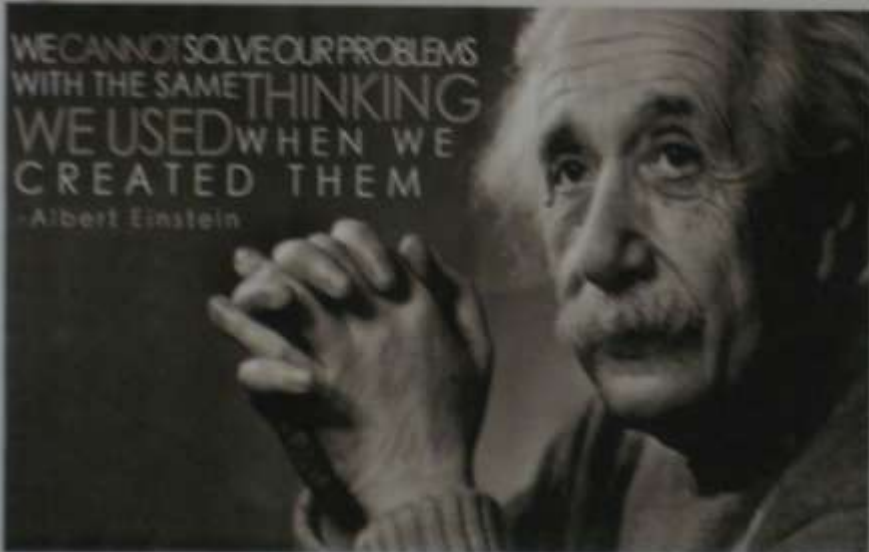
In 1826, Beethoven caught a cold coming back from his brother's place, with whom he had argued again. The illness complicated other health problems that Beethoven had suffered from all of his life. He passed away surrounded by his closest friends on March 26th 1827, just as a storm broke out.

- 1824: 9th symphony - Choral

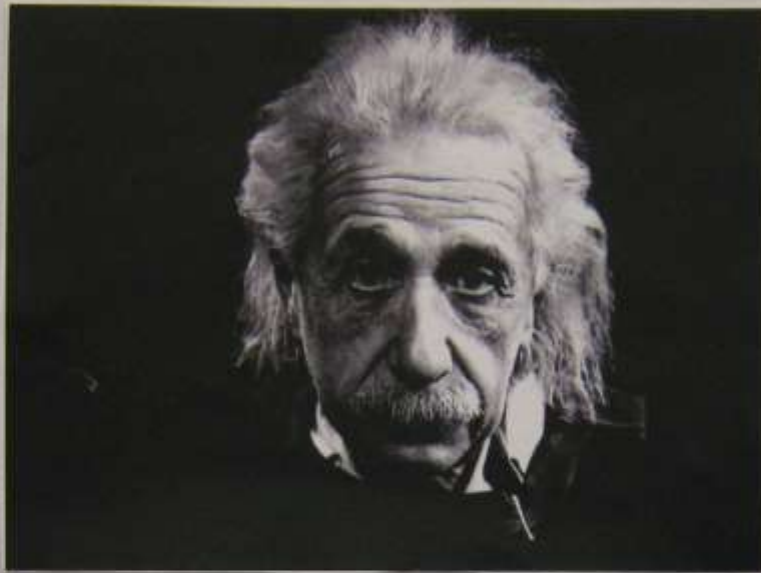
He died on April 18, 1955, in Princeton, New Jersey U.S.

Albert Einstein; 14 March 1879–18 April 1955) was a German-born theoretical physicist and philosopher of science. He received the 1921 for his "services to theoretical physics", in particular his discovery of the photoelectric effect, a pivotal step in the evolution of quantum theory.
